Jose Pino-y-Torres, M.D.



Dr. Jose Pino is a member of the radiation oncology physician group, Radiation Medicine Associates of Scranton (RAMAS), serves cancer patients at Upper Delaware Valley Cancer Center in Milford, where he is Medical Director.

He earned his undergraduate degree from College San Jose in Peru and his Medical Degree from the University of Madrid in Spain. He completed his Internship at Tucson Hospital, AZ, and his Residency at the University of Minnesota Affiliated Hospitals, MN. He also earned Fellowships in Hematology-Oncology at the Medical College of Wisconsin and Johns Hopkins Hospital, MD, and his Fellowship in Radiation Oncology at Johns Hopkins Hospital.

Dr. Pino is Board Certified in Internal Medicine, Radiation Oncology, Medical Oncology and Hematology. He is a clinical associate professor of medicine at the Commonwealth Medical College in Scranton.

Prior to coming to Pennsylvania, Dr. Pino served in various capacities as a Radiation Oncologist at major cancer centers in Florida. He was Chairman of the Radiation Oncology Department at Florida Hospital for 13 years; Founder and President of the Johns Hopkins Oncology Center in Winter Park; and Radiation Oncologist at M.D. Anderson Cancer Center in Orlando, FL.

Long affiliated with the National Cancer Institute, Dr. Pino is broadly trained in oncology and particularly skilled and experienced with many new, remarkable radiation therapy technologies, including Brachytherapy and Image Guided Radiation Therapy (IGRT) techniques.

Additionally, he was one of the first physicians in the state of Florida to offer Tomo Therapy: specialized radiation therapy that combines precise 3-D imaging from CT scans with highly targeted radiation beams.
